completing their perspective on a business plan? When was the last time it was updated?

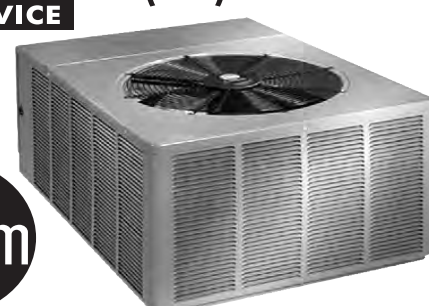
